Archijeunes

Built Environment Education (BEE) raises awareness of built and designed spaces. It encourages engagement with one's own living environment and empowers learners to actively shape it. The Archijeunes platform www.archijeunes.ch brings together numerous learning resources (in German, French and Italian) and represents the network for Built Environment Education in Switzerland.

How do spaces shape learning? How can existing spatial configurations and architectures be integrated into Built Environment Education processes? The Archijeunes Network Conference 2025 "[Cosmos School: Learning Spaces about Baukultur](#)" explored these questions.

The workshop provides a brief introduction to the fundamentals of Built Environment Education and invites participants to explore selected questions on spatial perception in the Sentimatt area. To reflect on these impressions, we draw on memories of school buildings and/ or university structures from our own biographies – and imagine possible future visions of learning environments that promote well-being and participation. In this way, key elements of Built Environment Education become directly tangible.
