

Vaccines recognised in Switzerland (as of 19 October 2021)

The following vaccines are recognised in Switzerland:

- **Pfizer/BioNTech** (BNT162b2 / Comirnaty® / Tozinameran)
- **Moderna** (mRNA-1273 / Spikevax / COVID-19 vaccine Moderna)
- **AstraZeneca** (AZD1222 Vaxzevria®), **Covishield**™
- **Janssen / Johnson & Johnson** (Ad26.COV2.S)

(People who have been vaccinated with these vaccines can apply for a Swiss Covid certificate on the online platform, if they do not already have an EU Certificate. Such a certificate costs CHF 30.)

Although the two vaccines listed below are recognised in Switzerland, it is not yet possible to apply for a Swiss Covid certificate:

- **Sinopharm / BIBP** (SARS-CoV-2 Vaccine (Vero Cell))
- **Sinovac** (CoronaVac)

Mixed vaccine doses:

Vaccinations that are complete according to the recommendations of the country where they were given will be accepted. So if a country's official recommendations allow mixed vaccines, this will be accepted.

(The FOPH recommendations also include 1 dose of mRNA after 1 dose of Astra Zeneca as a complete vaccination).
